"A Texas mining company plans to build a \$10 million rail loading terminal near Tomah that would allow one of the state's largest frac sand mines to ship its product to new markets. Smart Sand Inc. has applied to state and federal officials for permission to fill about 2.5 acres of wetlands for a proposed project that would include nearly 7 miles of looped track that could accommodate four trains longer than 1.5 miles.

The terminal would handle sand from Smart Sand's nearby 1,118-acre Oakdale mine..."
