**The Clean Water Act requires states to
establish water quality standards to ensure**

waters are swimmable, fishable, and drinkable and to review these standards every three years. In keeping with these requirements, the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) will be reviewing Wisconsin's water quality standards in a process called the Triennial Standards Review. This Review is an opportunity for the public and other important stakeholders to provide input on current water quality standards or guidance.

To begin this process, we are asking you to provide water quality standards related topics that you believe should be considered for the 2018-2020 Review. Topics evaluated in the Review include rules and guidance related to designated uses, water quality criteria, antidegradation, and water quality variances. Your input helps the DNR focus efforts to best protect the health of Wisconsin's lakes, rivers, and streams.
