A MESSAGE FROM DAVID BRAUN:

Dear Friends!

On behalf of a large and rapidly growing coalition of Californian, national, and international community, environmental justice, faith based, and climate organizations, I'm reaching out to urge you to [sign this letter to California Governor Jerry Brown](#) in advance of the upcoming Global Climate Action Summit in San Francisco. The deadline for sign-ons is February 9th.

The letter calls on the Governor to announce a halt on any new permits for fossil fuel projects and announce a phase out of existing production in line with Paris climate goals. As the World Bank and others are now showing, climate leadership must entail not allowing the indefinite expansion of fossil fuels industry, and plans must be made to wind down production within climate limits.

It also specifically calls out known community health impacts which California state scientists have identified, and Brown, sadly has ignored.

Please join us in asking Governor Brown to take the historic step of becoming the first elected leader of a major producing region to announce an end to industry expansion, and a managed decline of fossil fuels.

That, would be real climate leadership.
