Operation: Shake the Ground at the Foxconn Groundbreaking Ceremony

Foxconn is breaking ground this Tomorrow, June 28, in the Village of Mt. Pleasant. Guess who will be there? None other than President Trump, along with Governor Scott Walker, Paul Ryan and Foxconn CEO and Founder, Terry Gou. In response, a coalition of nearly 40 organizations will launch a mass demonstration entitled *Operation: Shake the Ground!*

This demonstration is drawing national media attention. HBO's Vice News plans to cover our

event! A good turnout is crucial to show that the people of Wisconsin are with us.

WHAT: Operation: Shake the Ground! will begin at noon with a rally at Smolenski Park highlighting the voices of landowners and residents impacted directly or indirectly by misuses of eminent domain and blighted zone rulings, changes in local transportation and local governance. We will then march approximately half an hour to Mt. Pleasant Village Hall for a second rally featuring voices from all over the state concerned with the economic, political, social and environmental repercussions from the Foxconn deal and the corrupt legislative body that approved it. Voter registration will be available during the event. Assembly, Senate and Gubernatorial candidates from throughout the state will be there too.

WHO: Student/youth leaders from *350 Stevens Point* and the *Gaia Coalition* got this started, but it's people like you - members of nearly 40 student and community organizations from throughout Wisconsin. You're part of a statewide coalition whose purpose is to oppose Foxconn and political corruption in Wisconsin. We're a diverse group with a core team of landowners and residents of Mount

Pleasant, Racine and Kenosha; students and youth leaders; environmentalists; civil rights advocates; interfaith communities; transportation advocates; public school teachers; UW professors; union workers; farmers and indigenous leaders.

*** *Building Unity* is part of this coalition. The Building Unity Tour will lead a carpool caravan from Madison. Meet in parking lot of HyVee West to leave by 9:15am or HyVee East to leave by 9:45am. We plan to be back in Madison around 7:30pm.**
