**EOG Resources Inc - Processing Plant, located at 1400 Halbleib Road, Chippewa Falls, Chippewa County, Wisconsin, FID 609072860, submitted to the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) a permit application, including plans and**

**specifications for original operation permit  
609072860-F01 for operation of a sand processing  
facility.**

**The Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources

revisions to Title I conditions in section I.D.1.**

**All comments received by the DNR at the public hearing if one is held, and prior to the close of the comment period, will be considered prior to making a final decision regarding the proposed project. After the close of the public comment period, a final decision will be made on whether to issue or deny the air pollution control permit.
