submitted to the Department of Natural  
Resources (DNR) a permit application,  
including plans and specifications for original  
operation permit 609072860-F01 for operation  
of a sand processing facility.  
The permit actions and numbers being noticed

are:

**Air pollution control non-Part 70 synthetic minor source operation permit no. 609072860-F01.**

**Air pollution control construction permit revision no. 11-POY-091-R1.**

**The Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources issues Air Pollution Control Operation Permits for sources of emissions, as required by chapter NR 407, Wis. Adm. Code, and Title V of the Clean Air Act (Act). The draft operation permit also contains revisions to Title I conditions in section I.D.1.**

#### **Application Review.**

**DNR has made a preliminary determination that the application meets state and federal air pollution control requirements and that the permit should be approved. The department has made the determination under ch. NR 150, Wis. Adm. Code, that this type of proposal normally does not have the potential to cause significant adverse environmental or secondary effects.

This is a preliminary determination and does not constitute a final approval from the Air Management Program or any other DNR sections which may also require a review of the project.

### **Public Hearing.**

DNR published a public notice on October 06, 2018. DNR received a request for a public hearing for the project on October 22, 2018. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, pursuant to ss. 285.13(1), 285.61(7), and 285.62(5) Wis. Stats., DNR will hold a public hearing to receive public comments on the air pollution control permit application for the proposed project.
