**The Public Hearing will be held on Badger Mining Corporation - Taylor Coating Plant, located at N7500 County Road P, Taylor, Jackson County, Wisconsin, FID 627005280, submitted to the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) a permit application, including plans and specifications for renewal of air pollution control Part 70 operation permit no. 627005280-P10 for operation of a resin-coated sand or ceramic pellets production facility and revision of air pollution control construction permit 12-MHR-176. The following permit actions and numbers are being noticed:**

**Air pollution control non-Part 70 synthetic minor source operation permit renewal no. 627005280-F20.**

**Air pollution control construction permit revision 12-MHR-176-R1**

**Air pollution control construction permit revision 12-MHR-176-R2**

**The Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources issues Air Pollution Control Operation Permits for sources of emissions, as required by chapter NR 407, Wis. Adm. Code, and Title V of the Clean Air Act (Act). The draft operation permit also contains no revisions to Title I conditions outside of those contained in the construction permit revisions being noticed concurrently with the draft operation permit.**

### **Application Review.**

**DNR has made a preliminary determination that the application meets state and federal air pollution control re-quirements and that the permit should be approved. issue or deny the air pollution control permit.
