**sand mining operations debated their positions
before Judge Scott Horne in the Trempealeau
Circuit Court in Whitehall, WI on Monday,
December 2, 2019. The Judge asked that there be a
more detailed delineation of the neighbors' claims**

so that the neighbors can demand information
from the mine's operators.

Another hearing will be held on Jan. 31.
The trial of the case is not likely to start until the
summer of 2020.
