**Frac sand mining companies seem to be biting the dust and causing more consternation for county taxpayers in several parts of the state of Wisconsin.**

**At an earlier date, according to statements from the DNR, Preferred Sands filed for reorganization in 2013. This past year, Emerge Energies/Superior Silica Sands has filed for bankruptcy, and now the owners of Wisconsin White Sand, LLC, have closed up shop. They owe a quarter of million dollars in property taxes as well as about \$800,000 to private firms. Will there be enough funds for reclamation?**
