**"Minnesota has jumped into the climate litigation fray with a lawsuit seeking to hold ExxonMobil, Koch Industries and the American Petroleum Institute accountable for their role in accelerating climate change and the damage it has already caused."**

**"Attorney General Keith Ellison filed the lawsuit Wednesday in Ramsey County District Court to stop deceptive practices by Exxon, three Koch industries entities and API related to the sale and promotion of**

**petroleum products known to cause climate change, saying in a statement that they "have harmed Minnesotans' health and our state's environment, infrastructure, and economy."**
